Presentation of illness in the older person

In the older person, illnesses may present as geriatric syndromes rather than typical symptoms. Some of these syndromes are:

- Impaired memory / confusion
- Difficulty in walking / falls
- Incontinence

The aim of Geriatric Medicine is to assess the medical, functional and psychosocial status of the older person and to develop strategies and interventions to improve outcomes in a multidisciplinary approach.

At Specialist Outpatient Clinic, Geriatric Centre Khoo Teck Puat Hospital & Centre for Geriatric Medicine in Tan Tock Seng Hospital, we have outpatient programmes to meet the needs of the older person. We have four specialised clinics as well as individual geriatric clinics.

Geriatric outpatient programmes and clinic

Geriatric Assessment Clinic/ General Geriatric Clinic

The clinic provides comprehensive assessment of older persons (65 years and above) who have more than one geriatric syndromes or recent decline in the ability to perform activities of daily living. Geriatric rehabilitation services will also be provided to improve the elderly's functions.

Falls and Balance Clinic

The clinic is where older persons (65 years and above) with recurrent falls and gait problems are assessed by a geriatrician, nurse clinician, physiotherapist and occupational therapist. The aim is to identify the causes of falls in the individual patient and develop a care plan to help prevent further falls.

Cognition and Memory Disorders Service

The clinic is specialised for ambulant older persons (65 years and above) with memory and cognitive impairments. The assessments are conducted by a multi-disciplinary team comprising of the geriatrician, nurse clinician, as well as psychologist and therapist where applicable.

Continence Clinic

The clinic offers evaluation and treatment of older female persons (65 years and above) with urinary incontinence. Male patients should be referred to Urology who will refer to Continence clinic if needed.

Please note the clinics are specialised in the area as stated above. As such, other concomitant medical problems are best addressed by the patient's GP or other attending physician.
