Advanced technology is increasingly used alongside conventional therapies in stroke rehabilitation, especially in community settings.

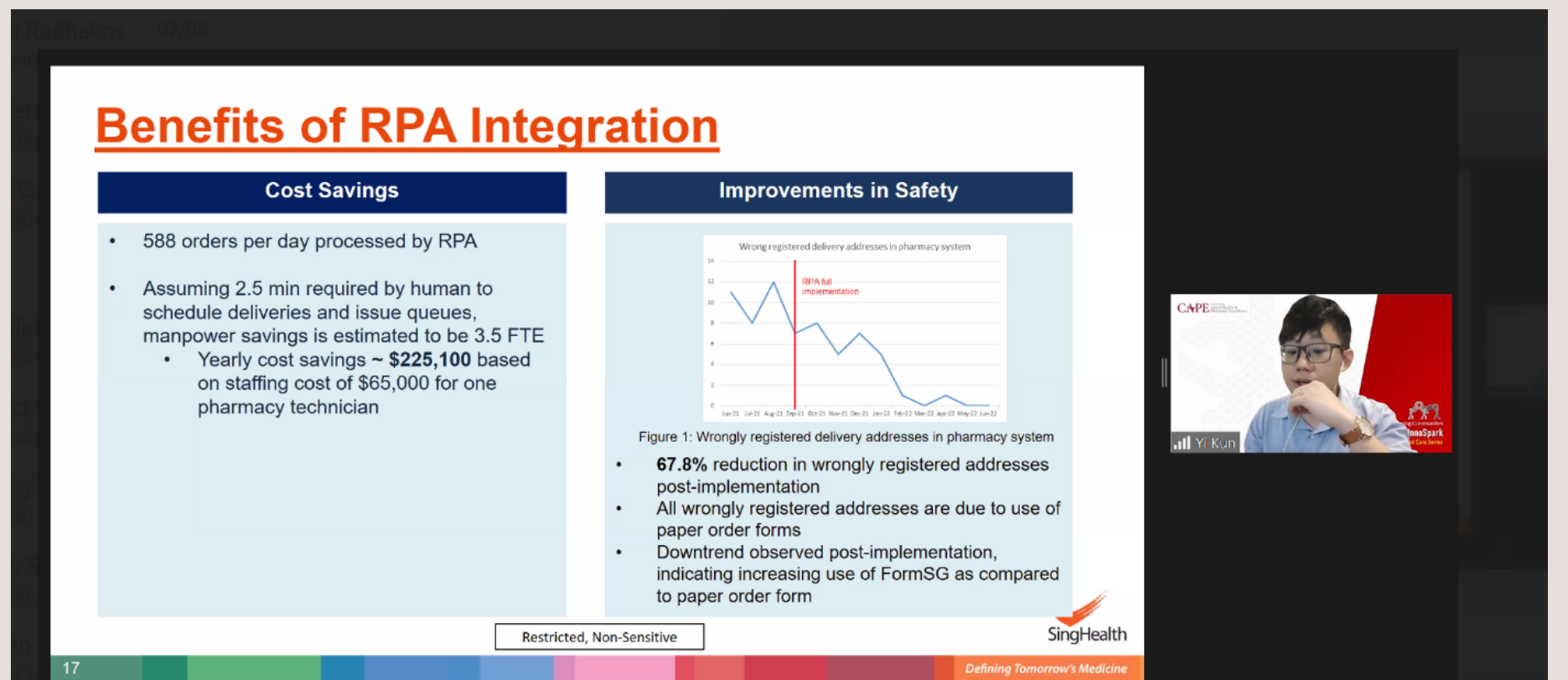

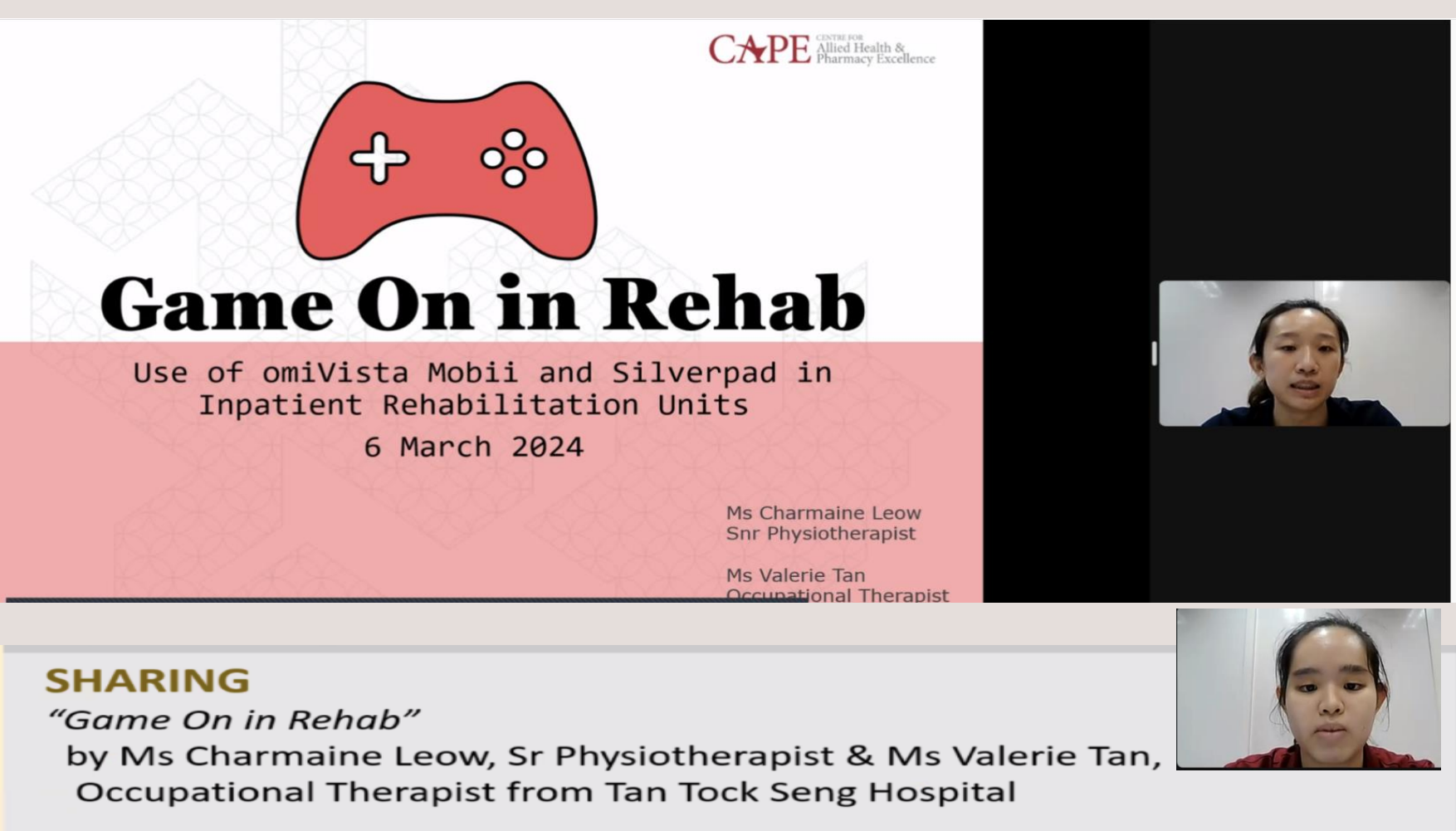


COMMUNITY CARE SERIES - ELDERCARE TRACK SEASON 2

As we navigate the ever-changing landscape of technology in providing care across health and community settings, it is crucial to continuously explore, understand, and exchange insights on how technology can enhance our care environments.

GAME ON IN REHAB

Gamification in eldercare promotes well-being by enhancing cognitive function, social engagement, and physical activity. The Omi Vista Mobii, an innovative motion-activated projection system, and Silverpad, a senior-friendly tablet with activities tailored to the local population, were introduced during the Innovation & Technology in Eldercare session on March 6th. Ms. Charmaine, a Senior Physiotherapist from TTSH, introduced Omi Vista Mobii, while Ms. Valerie, an Occupational Therapist, shared about Silverpad.



ELDER CARE TECH FINALE - INNOVATION SHOWCASE

The season on technology in elderly care wrapped up with a physical event on July 10th, where attendees engaged in interactive demonstrations and discussions with partners.

Notable technologies showcased included DEXIE, a humanoid robot from Goshen Consultancy Services; PARO, a therapeutic robot by Dementia Singapore; and CRDL, an interactive music instrument by Sancare Asia. Additional innovations featured were the I-OK Ecosystem by Lions Befrienders, immersive tools like Omi Vista Mobii and Silver Pad by ICH Rehab Therapists, and the CHI Learning & Development System (CHILD). These technologies aim to enhance patient and client participation in various care settings, including AACs, DRCs, and NHs.
