About ASG Befriending Service

ASG* Befriending Service was started by a group of Allied Health Professionals from Tan Tock Seng Hospital Rehabilitation Centre and Ang Mo Kio–Thye Hua Kwan Hospital (AMK-THKH) in December 2018.

It strives to enhance social integration for PWAs* through peer befriending and personal empowerment.

*ASG – Amputee Support Group

*PWAs – Persons With Amputations

What are Our Objectives?



To encourage and support PWAs who have recently gone through amputations



To expand social network of PWAs and promote mutual aid



To promote PWAs activation in the community



Who are the Befrienders?

All befrienders are our former patients with amputations. They are a group of dedicated and passionate volunteers who wish to support PWAs by sharing their experiences and resources.



What Do the Befrienders do?

Our befrienders conduct physical visits within the hospital and teleconferences with PWAs. They provide basic emotional support, useful information and companionship.

Are the Befrienders Trained?

Yes. Each befriender would have attended the Volunteer Induction Program by the Hospital Volunteer Management Team, and undergo yearly trainings conducted by the organising team.

Am I Suitable for the Service?

ASG Befriending Service can be provided in inpatient and outpatient settings. If you would like to hear more from our befrienders, approach your medical and allied health team for a discussion and referral.

What is the Process Like?

Once a referral is made,

The referral will be reviewed

A befriender to be identified

Referral source will be contacted

First session to be arranged

*Please note that the first session will be conducted with a befriender and one Allied Health member from the organising team.
