



# Haematuria means there is blood in the urine.

While haematuria is quite common, it should always be investigated because **sometimes it may be due to a serious problem.**



## COMMON SYMPTOMS

- Cola Colored Urine
- Pink Urine
- Bright Red Urine

(This may or may not be visible to the naked eye)

## CAUSES

- Infection in urinary tract
- Urinary tract stones
- Prostatic enlargement (males)
- Cancers of urinary tract
- Injury to urinary tract
- Kidney disease
- Postmenopausal changes

## DIAGNOSIS

- Urine tests
- Radiological tests (X-ray, Intravenous urogram, Ultrasound, CT scan etc)
- Flexible cystoscopy
- Blood tests (occasionally)
