## What is Kidney Failure?



A patient's kidneys can deteriorate despite best treatment and care. It is estimated that **4.7 new patients** are diagnosed with kidney failure every day in Singapore.

#### Function of Our Kidneys



Controlling the fluid in your body



Removing blood toxins




Maintaining normal blood biochemistry such as potassium, phosphate and acid



Producing hormones to maintain blood count and bone health

#### As our own kidneys fail, we will need to find other ways to replace its functions.

Glomerular Filtration Rate (GFR) can be estimated from a blood test and is a measure of kidney function.

These symptoms may arise at low levels of kidney function:












Breathlessness Leg swelling

# What are My Options when My Kidneys Fail?



## 1 Peritoneal Dialysis

Daily home-based dialysis therapy which uses the abdomen as a filter.

Patients or caregivers instill clean dialysis fluid into patient's abdomen for dialysis.




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### Hemodialysis

Centre-based therapy is performed in a dialysis centre at least 3 times a week.

A patient's blood will be cleansed via a filter attached to a machine before being returned to the patient's body.




#### **Kidney Transplantation** 3

Surgical transplantation of a functioning kidney into a patient who has kidney failure.

Once in place, the new kidney replaces the function of the old kidneys. If the transplant is successful, dialysis is not needed.

A patient may receive the donation of a functioning kidney from a loved one or a deceased donor under the Human Organ Transplantation Act.



#### **Conservative Management**

Sometimes, patients may decide not to undergo the above treatment options.

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Medications can be given to help alleviate the symptoms that may arise with worsening kidney function.

Advanced Care Planning can also be done to discuss future care preferences between an individual, their family and healthcare providers.



The aim is to provide comfort care until patients pass on.

#### Focus on what best suits you...

Most patients feel overwhelmed with the news of kidney failure. However, with appropriate preparation, the outcome can be positive.

Early discussion with your family, renal counsellors and doctor will help you understand more to make an informed decision.


