What Is Orthodontics?

Orthodontics is the branch of dentistry that focuses on identifying, preventing and treating teeth misalignment and modification of facial growth. Fixing tools such as braces can move teeth into proper alignment, improve bite and re-establish good facial balance

Who Needs Braces?

Below are some pictures of common teeth problems that can be treated by Orthodontists.



Overjet –
Protruding upper front teeth



Overbite – Upper teeth cover too much of the lower teeth



Underbite – Lower front teeth protrude in front of upper front teeth



Crossbite – Upper teeth bite inside the lower teeth



Crowding – When there is too little space to fit all the teeth



Open bite –
Front teeth not touching when back teeth are closed together



Spacing –When there is too much space in between teeth

What are the Different Types of Braces?

There are two main types – (1) fixed braces and (2) removable braces.

- (1) Fixed braces are
- •usually made of metal
- •also made of tooth-coloured (ceramic or plastic) braces
- (2) Removable braces
- •can be taken out when you brush your teeth

Your Orthodontist will advise which type of braces is best for you.



Ceramic Bracket System



Lingual braces – Fixed braces attached to the inside of the lower teeth



Metal Bracket System



Aligners – Clear removable braces

Plastic plate with
clips on teeth



Space maintainers

Used to keep spaces while waiting for adult teeth to come through

Your Orthodontist will go through your dental problems and explain how braces can help you.

Your diagnostic records will be used to suggest a treatment method suited for you. Examples of diagnostic records include digital X-rays, clinical photographs and dental impressions.
