




Dietary Restrictions Three Days Before Colonoscopy

Take only light, low-fibre meals such as:



Stop taking any oily and high-fibre foods such as:



Medications for preparation: PICOPREP / PICOPREP and PEG

PICOPREP

- This is a drug (laxative) which stimulates the muscle in the intestines, in order to create bowel movements (pass motion).
- You may experience stomach cramps and diarrhoea after taking the medication.

2. Polyethylene Glycol Electrolyte Solution (PEG)

- It is used to clean out the gastrointestinal tract (stomach and intestines).
- You may experience diarrhoea, nausea and/or stomach cramps after taking the medication.

Important Notes:

- ✓ Do see a doctor at your nearest clinic if you experience vomiting or severe abdominal pain (stomachache).
- Depending on your procedure type, you will be required to take either:
 - "PICOPREP" (Page 4) OR
 - "PICOPREP + PEG" (Page 5 and 6)
- Please refer to the correct instructions for your procedure preparation

Drink at least 1 litre or 2 cups of plain water (1 cup = 500ml), using the PICOPREP cup given.

6PM-6.30PM Light low-fibre dinner.

No more food allowed after 6.30PM.

8PM-9PM Prepare the PICOPREP solution to drink

by mixing 1 packet of powder with 150 ml of warm water, and stirring for

2 to 3 minutes.

Drink at least 1 litre or 2 cups of plain

water (1 cup = 500ml), using the PICOPREP

cup given.

No more food allowed after 7PM.

by mixing 1 packet of powder with 150 ml of warm water and stirring for

2 to 3 minutes.

Drink at least 1 litre or 2 cups of plain

water (1 cup = 500ml), using the

PICOPREP cup given.



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PICOPREP + PEG

(Follow instructions on Page 5 and 6)

12 midnight onwards


No food allowed

5AM-6AM

- Stop and do not take these medications______.
- Continue other usual medications. Take it at least 2 hours before your colonoscopy, with small amounts of water.



Mix 1 packet of PEG powder with 1 litre or 4 cups of plain water (1 cup = 250 ml). Start drinking 1 litre of PEG solution from 5AM and complete by 6AM.

Your doctor may advise additional medications for your bowel preparation.


Stool Number Chart:
