Ward Activities & Facilities



You will be briefed on the ward layout, facilities and instructions on operating hospital equipment.

Breakfast is served from 07.00am, **lunch** from 11.30am and **dinner** from 5.30pm.

Please inform your nurse before consuming outside food.



Your **medical team** will see you daily and provide updates on your treatment plan.



Your Doctor/Nurse

will inform your tentative discharge date and time when you are ready for discharge.

Hospital policy



Visiting hours:

12.00pm - 2.00pm and 5.00pm - 8.00pm
(Max 2 visitors allowed at your bedside.)

Photography and video recording are not permitted within the hospital premises.



Smoking and vaping are strictly prohibited.

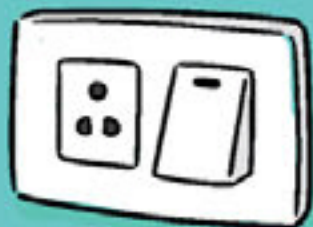
Offenders will be fined \$1000. Do not bring cigarettes or e-cigarette to the hospital.



In the event of a fire emergency please follow the instructions of the ward nurse for an orderly evacuation.



Ensure electrical plug for your personal equipment is **certified with safety mark.**



Please approach your nurse if you wish to use the ward electrical outlets.

Patient Advisory



You will need to **provide your full name and NRIC number** frequently to ensure accurate treatment.

Inform your - Doctor/Nurse of any implants or medical devices you may have.



Please bring your medications to the hospital and do not self-medicate unless instructed by your nurse.



Always wear your wrist tags during your stay and for your safety, do inform us of any allergies you may have.



Bring an extra set of clean clothes for your discharge.

Do not leave the hospital premises without checking with your Doctor/Nurse.



Lastly, identify a spokesperson who will be the primary point of contact to receive confidential information and communicate with the care team regarding your treatment plan.

Your caregiver may stay with you at the bedside to care for you outside visiting hours and we may have services available to support them.

If you have any concerns about your treatment plan or any feedback, do let us know.



Please remember to wash your hands with your hands and follow the infection control practices as advised by your nurse.



Please take care of your valuables/belongings and personal equipment during your stay.
