Patient Service Associate

Our Patient Service Associates (PSAs) play a vital role in providing quality frontline service to the patients and the public. Based at specialist outpatient clinics, pharmacy, wards and the emergency department, they are important touch points in our patients' care journey. They assist with walk-in enquiries, registration, scheduling appointments, room assisting and care coordination.

TTSH is the **first** restructured hospital in Singapore to provide PSAs with the opportunity to perform clinical responsibilities. PSAs are trained to support clinical duties, working alongside medical professionals to facilitate care delivery.







Patient Information Associate

Patient Information Associates (PIAs) proactively engage with the Hospital's visitors and help to facilitate their visits to the in-patient wards. They play an important role in ensuring that Hospital visitors have an enjoyable time here at TTSH.

PIAs will meet a wide variety of unique individuals each day, and hence, must have the social skills to manage everyone in a professional and polite manner. They attend to wayfinding and general enquiries from the public and patients within the HealthCity Novena campus.
